

Page Creation Cycle

Create a New Page

1. Search for an existing page.
2. The results page will have a link to start a new page.
3. Start the page with "About this page" to explain the page purpose. Include your name as author in this section.
4. Add the page to your "watch list" so you can track changes made by others.
5. When finished, modify the Table of Contents to include the new page.

Edit an Existing Page

1. Should you really change this? If so, use the Edit tab.
2. Use "Discussion" to propose changes to pages authored by others and to document your own changes.

Moving Pages

1. The wiki will automatically make a redirect from the old page to the new one to avoid dead link syndrome.
2. If you don't want a redirect, copy your WikiText somewhere safe and delete the page using the Delete tab.

Uploading Images

Use "Upload File" in toolbox
